

# Men's Club Competition Rules, and 2011 Champions

All competitions, except stroke play champs and match play events, will be decided by count back where possible. The nature of some events may present the need to find a winner by lot (e.g. best 2 of 3 rounds with counting rounds falling on different rounds).

Competition play on Sundays will not commence before 9.00am and players will be drawn by the starter. Tees close for competition play at 10.30am.

Cards must be correctly completed for the days competition and signed by the player and marker. Cards not correctly completed will not be accepted by the Match Committee.

## Match Play Events

1. Entries will be taken for the Match Play Champs in the weeks leading up to the event.
2. All match play events are to be decided on the stipulated date (see note a below). Championship finals must be played on the stipulated date.
3. Starting times will be set and adhered to according to the rules of golf.
  - a. Note: If you wish to play at an alternative time (must be played before the stipulated date) you must apply to the club captain for authorisation of this. Please note that your application may not be granted.
  - b. If play is suspended on any day, the match committee will advise a postponement date or how to proceed.
4. If a match is all square after 18 holes (36 holes in finals (except junior B)), play must continue from the first tee until a hole is won.

<b>Stroke Play Championships</b>	<p>1. The winner will be the competitor who completes 3 of the 4 stipulated rounds in the least number of strokes.</p> <p>2. Divisions will be determined by the match committee.</p> <p>In the event of a tie, the winner will be found over an 18 hole playoff. If competitors are still tied, sudden death on the 18th hole. To be played at a time mutually agreed by both players and the match committee. The earlier this can be played, the better.</p> <p>Note: The only valid reason for not completing a round is if play is suspended by the match committee.</p>

### **Alterations to Programme**

Please consult club notice board and website ([www.pirongjagolfclub.co.nz](http://www.pirongjagolfclub.co.nz)) regarding all club competitions and tournaments. Course conditions may require the programme to be amended or varied. Detailed rules for all competitions are posted on the website and may be posted on the notice board prior to the play of competition.

### **Championship Pennants**

This is a Waikato Interclub match play team's event. Teams are spread over 6 divisions, with 8 teams in a division. A team plays every other team in their division before the top two play off in a final.

The match committee selects a team of 6 players. On each day, foursomes are played in the morning and singles in the afternoon.

### **Prebble Cup**

This is a Waikato Interclub knockout match play event.

The match committee selects a team of 8 players; four on handicap index 5.0 – 14.4 (seniors) and 4 on 14.5 – 24.0 (juniors). Foursomes are played in the morning and singles in the afternoon.

### **Handicap Pennants**

This is a Waikato Interclub stroke play event.

The match committee selects a team of 4 players (up to h'cap index 24.0). Play will be over two rounds of 27 holes of medal play with all scores from each team to count for each round. The top four teams from each zone, plus ties, will qualify for a further two rounds of 27 holes. The final two rounds will be played on the same basis as the preliminary rounds however scores from the preliminary rounds will not be carried forward to the finals.
